- Pollution Prevention Produces Results (2006)
 - <http://www.p2.org/assets/pdf/P2ProducesResults>

- Waste Reduction: 6 Billion Pounds
- Water Conservation: 44 Billion Gallons
- Energy Conservation: 1.2 Billion Kilowatt Hours
- Cost Savings: \$500 million
 - 5 times Return on Investment
- Since 1990
 - 175 B pounds; 50 B Gallons; 2 B Kwh; \$1.2 B


